AUDITION AND FINALIST TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

By participating in the ONE HIT WONDER EVENT PTY LTD, each Competitor ("Event Competitor") agrees to be bound by these Official Rules (the "Event Rules"), which are final and binding in all respects.

- 1.1 To be eligible to Audition for THE ONE HIT WONDER EVENT PTY LTD, Event Competitors must correctly submit high quality video footage to auditions@onehitwonderevent.com via THE ONE HIT WONDER EVENT PTY LTD website www.onehitwonderevent.com.
- 1.2 Event Competitors must submit their Audition within the Audition Phase Duration; 12th of June 2011 – 20th August 2011.
- 1.3 View instructions for how to enter, including footage upload instructions www.onehitwonderevent.com/audition.
- 1.4 Event Competitors agree that THE ONE HIT WONDER EVENT PTY LTD and its major sponsor TOYOTA MOTOR CORPORATION AUSTRALIA LIMITED ('TOYOTA'), has Owners Rights ("Owners Rights") to the Audition footage, including the right to alter, change, modify, edit, repackage, and redistribute the submitted footage in any media, by its Sponsors and without compensation of any kind and without notice, or approval.
- 1.5 Event Competitors grant THE ONE HIT WONDER EVENT PTY LTD and its major sponsors the perpetual, on-going right to use Event Competitor's name, age, town and Audition footage for the purpose of identifying the Event Competitor, and for promotional activities.
